Remote Meetings Authorization Extended to March 31, 2023

Our friends at the Massachusetts Nonprofit Network (**MNN**) have been working with a coalition of nonprofits and associations toward an extension of the state's pandemic-driven authorization for remote member meetings. On July 14th, the House and Senate sent Governor Baker a bill which included an extension of the time for nonprofits to hold remote member meetings through **March 31st, 2023**. On July 16th, Lieutenant Governor Polito signed the bill in her capacity as Acting Governor. **MNN** and many others will continue to work in the months ahead to make remote member meetings authorization permanent.
